

# RAND HRS 2020 Fat File

## 1). Important Things to Note:

- a). The RAND HRS 2020 Fat File is based on HRS 2020 Core (Early V2.0, August 2022) data, and the HRS Tracker 2020 (Early V2.0, December 2022) file.
- b). The RAND HRS 2020 Fat File does not include the raw variables from the pension (PR\_P) or jobs (PR\_JB) preloads sections. The raw variables from the pension (J\_P) section, however, are included in the Fat Files, and have been transposed to the Respondent level.
- c). RAND HRS Fat File documentation can be found on the [RAND Center for the Study of Aging](#) website. Please note, however, that these documents are unlike traditional codebooks in the sense that they do not contain information about specific variables from the survey (e.g., frequencies, question text, etc.). For this, we recommend that users examine the [HRS Codebooks](#) and [HRS Questionnaires](#) for the key variables under study.
