Please note, however, that these documents are unlike traditional codebooks in the sense that they do not contain information about specific variables from the survey (e.g., frequencies, question text, etc.). For this, we recommend that users examine the <u>HRS Codebooks</u> and <u>HRS Questionnaires</u> for the key variables under study.
